



# HOW TO READ YOUR TOWN OF Middletown Electric Bill



Dear Resident:

Effective November 1, 2018 we started reading and storing both your Delivered and Generated readings. Delivered are the kWh that your dwelling has consumed and will be labeled "Electric". Generated are the kWh put onto the Town's electric system from your solar panels and will be labeled "Generated".

When you receive your bill this month the current meter activity section of your utility bill will contain two lines of electric readings; "Electric" which represents your delivered kWh and "Generated" which represents the kWh put onto the Town's electric system from your solar panels.

The difference between the usage data for each reading type is the amount billed or stored as a kWh credit on your utility account. Credits of kWh accumulate on your utility account to offset future billing periods. The example directly above will result in an electric bill of 426 kWh. Any time the Electric usage is greater than the Generate usage a bill of kWh will occur.

In the example directly above, the result is a credit of 96 kWh on this utility account. Any time the Generated usage is greater than the Electric usage, the utility account will have a kWh credit.
